1. The Bureau of Ordnance nominates Librascope, Incorporated, Burbank, California, for the Army-Navy Production Award, after giving due consideration to the report of the Inspector of Naval Material, enclosure (A), and other factors.

2. Subject company has done outstanding work as a prime contractor producing antiaircraft fire control computers. The company is currently producing in excess of 200 instruments per month as compared with an estimated plant capacity of 170 units per month. It has demonstrated considerable ingenuity in designing and producing special machinery and equipment of a highly complicated nature necessary for the production of these instruments. The quality of material supplied is excellent and cooperation has been most satisfactory.

3. This company is highly recommended by the Bureau of Ordnance for the award on the basis of its excellent production record, high quality of work, cooperation, and demonstrated ability to meet contract schedules.
